Health Visitors are all qualified nurses and many have also had midwifery experience as well as having further training in areas such as child development, community health and health promotion.

They work mainly with parents and young children and will visit you soon after you return home with your new baby.

Our Health Visitor runs child health clinics and works alongside Dr Carey and Dr Raphael at the surgery as well as offering support group and other services.

### At your first appointment with the Midwife

At your first appointment with the midwife arrangements will be made for you to be seen at your home or at Mill Lane Clinic. The midwife will complete the pregnancy notes with you, which you will then keep for the remainder of your pregnancy.

You can discuss where you would prefer to have your baby. The differences in the facilities provided will be explained.

The blood screening tests will be explained to you and you will be given information about these to help you to make your decision. The midwife will inform you when these tests are necessary.

Information about the midwifery service will be given to you including the patterns of care and where you may go to have your care.

You will be invited to free "Parent craft" sessions which are held in the evenings. These sessions are organised by the midwives and health visitors and will help to prepare you for labour and bringing your baby home.
